Upon application of Mr Attorney S Sookia for the Applicant and after taking cognizance of the said application and attached documents and being satisfied that the matter is so urgent as to require the immediate intervention of the Tribunal and before notice of the application is served on the Respondent, let an interim order issue restraining and prohibiting the Respondent whether directly

or indirectly through any Company, Officer, Agent, Préposé or otherwise from launching or participating in a strike, threatened strike or any matter preparatory to a strike in the Transport Industry in relation to the Applicant pending the final disposal of the present application.

The above interim order is to remain in force until Tuesday 14th of October 2014 at 10.30 am., when the Tribunal orders the abovenamed Respondent to appear before the Tribunal to show cause why the interim order should not be enlarged, discharged or otherwise dealt with after hearing parties and why other prayer should not be granted.

The above interim order is issued on Applicant's own risks and perils and upon its undertaking, through its Attorney to abide by an order which may be made thereafter as to damages to the Respondent by the granting of this interim order.
